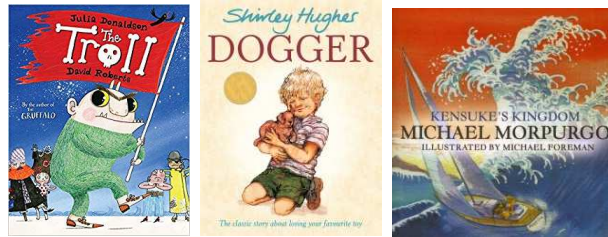
A weekly note from your headteacher...
