The following statement has been issued by NYCC this week.

Updated information on the issuing of Penalty Notices for unauthorised leave of absence (holiday) in term time.

The Supreme Court has now overturned the High Court ruling and found in favour of the IOW, I wish to inform you that the council is resuming it's original position with immediate effect and will be issuing all Penalty Notices ...which meet the criteria of ten or more unauthorised sessions leave (in a block or accumulatively over a four month period) taken without the permission of the school, and where the reason given does not meet any criteria for exceptional circumstances.

Please note 10 sessions is one school week and all paperwork has been requested by the Local Authority.
