School Games Week 2017 26th – 30th June

The week will be filled with a range of activities which celebrate different kinds of sports, skills and achievements – there will be something for everyone! As there will be sports activities held every day we ask that all children and adults come to school dressed and ready for sport with hats/sun cream (if its's sunny!), jewellery removed, and their outdoor school PE kit.

As always we cannot plan for the weather. If the weather is unfavourable events may need to be cancelled.

Monday – Parents welcome – 9.00am warm up followed by 'school teams' rotating round a series of activities. Come along and support the children as they show off their skills

Tuesday – Parents welcome – 1.00pm our traditional sports afternoon with age group races on the track

Wednesday – Parents welcome – 1.00pm is the official 'opening' of our play equipment, with a 'Family Fitness and Fun Run' activity. Children (and family members!) will be able to see who can complete the most laps on our running course, impress us with their skipping skills or rest in the shade with a drink! This will also be the deadline for our sponsored activity where we will see how many kilometres of activity we have clocked up as a school!! **2.45pm – 3.15pm** an introduction to and training for our new school defibrillator will be available for those who are interested. Defibrillators do save lives and we have purchased one (suitable for children and adults) as a school from our fundraising.

Thursday – The children will get to take part in an athletics activity and a team game event. These events are being delivered by sport's coaches working alongside our teaching staff.

Friday – A day of dance with Jo Gatenby. Each class will learn a contemporary dance routine which we hope to be able to perform at the end of the day on our new outdoor stage (2.30pm) for those who can come to join us for our Friday Celebration of Achievements.

FoSS will be providing refreshments to parents on Tuesday afternoon, donations of cakes would be appreciated, in addition ice creams will be on sale on Wednesday afternoon.
