Exciting times ahead.....

Looking towards the next school year plans are being put into place for many new and exciting activities including:

National Trust Folly – Mrs Sowray applied to the National Trust for Rievaulx to take part in an exciting plan to be involved in the creating of a Folly at Fountains Abbey. We have just heard that our application has been successful. We will be visited in the Autumn Term by an architect who will work with the class throughout the project.

Inspire Performance 2017-18 - Every Monday afternoon during the next school year Ed, a Sports Coach from Queen Ethelburgas, will be back in school with Louise Woodward, a Performing Arts Coach. Each term a different class will be working with them culminating in an end of term performance at QE.

Forest Schools Project – Mr Houghton is currently undergoing training to become a Forest School Leader, commencing in the Autumn Term he will be working with the children to develop a Forest School Area within the school grounds, incorporating the Wildlife Area, the top of the field and the willow dome.
