



## Rievaulx Newsletter Summer 2

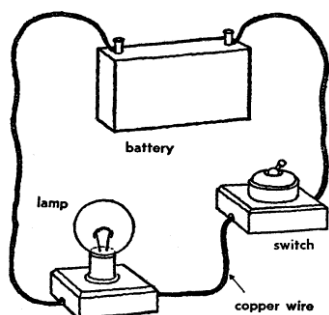
Welcome back and hope you had a lovely half term in the sunshine!
