NOTICES:

Yesterday afternoon we received Government guidance for September 2020 and I am so happy that it confirmed 'that all pupils, in all year groups, will return to school full-time from the beginning of the autumn term. Circumstances have changed. The prevalence of coronavirus (COVID-19) has decreased, our NHS Test and Trace system is up and running, and we are clear about the measures that need to be in place to create safer environments within schools. Returning to school is vital for children's education and for their wellbeing'.

In light of the guidance, all that we have been doing as a Federation meets government requirements often going beyond and there is just a couple of amendments I will need to make to plans and risk assessments ready for September. Due to the mixing of groups protective measures I am going to have Year 4 at Husthwaite in Class 2 with Miss Goodchild full time, most certainly for the Autumn term. I will review this as government guidance evolves during the Autumn term and if possible will put Year 4 in with Class 3 later in the academic year if still appropriate to support transition into upper key stage 2 and safe to do so. I am sure you will understand that this is the safest measure to take to limit the mixing of groups as much as possible.

I will be producing and sending out a September 2020 School Guide next week to ensure that everyone is aware, well in advance of what to expect in September.

I would very much appreciate your opinions in writing as to not only your child's report and this academic year, but also your opinions as to how we as a Federation have supported you and your child both academically / mental health and wellbeing/general support through COVID-19 Lockdown.
