I can't believe we're now into a new decade... we start the year with a busy and exciting six week half term.

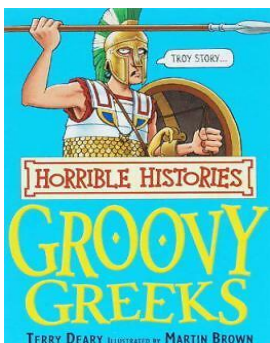

This half term, we have gymnastics in the hall on a Thursday afternoon and another outdoor P.E. session at some point during the week. We just need to work with the weather!



This half term our topic is **'Who let the Gods out?'** and we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks and how they have influenced the world today.



To bring the topic to life, Mrs Watson & I have booked a fantastic trip to the Life Science Centre in Newcastle. We will look round the museum itself, have an Ancient Greek science workshop and ice skating before the journey home.





In Science, the Year 4's will be learning about **'Sound'** - how sounds are made, how our ears work and how sounds become fainter with distance.

In computing, Year 4's will continue to use 2code on Purple Mash. Children will learn how to programme and move objects on the screen. They will work through a series of lessons to build up their skills of coding.

The children will also be learning about E- safety (11th February is Safer Internet Day.) As part of our history and geography, they will use the laptops and ipads to research information about Ancient Greece.
