Denver, for his creative junk model car and being able to name all the shapes; rectangle, square and circle. Brilliant maths work Denver!

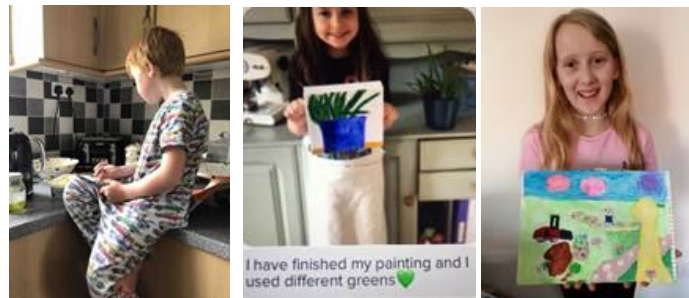
Class 2
