



A 'Friday Celebration' note from Miss. Bennett...

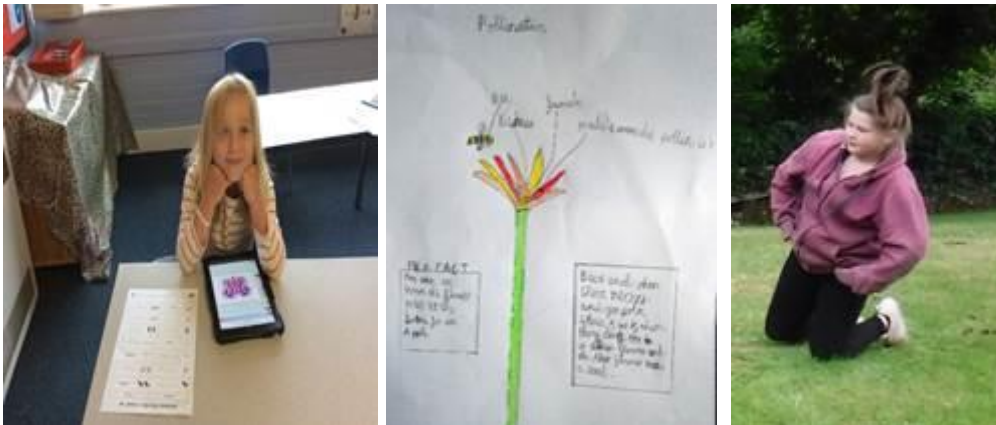
Another busy week for all! The weather has certainly been changeable, fingers crossed for some more sunshine!
