Please can I remind parents of children in Reception , Years 1 and 2 that your children are entitled to a school dinner at no cost to yourselves under the government Universal Free School Meal Scheme. This year we have signed up to North Yorkshire’s Healthy Schools. As part of this we will be promoting the importance of a balanced diet and will be looking at healthy school lunches and pack ups. We will be encouraging a varied diet and as part of this will be limiting children on hot dinners to no more than two jacket potatoes a week. Occasional tasters will be on offer to all children entitled at times over the following few weeks to encourage your children to maybe try something new.

For your information as you know we normally hold an informal parent evening this half term for you with your child’s class teacher. This is to discuss how your child has settled into the new academic year, their strengths and areas for improvement and any individual needs they may have. As due to the current circumstances we are unable to do this face to face, you will be sent a summary beginning of term written report informing you of how they have settled and your child’s behavior to learning now they are back in school full time. Their strengths and targets for improvement. You will be given the opportunity for a follow up phone call should you wish to discuss anything further with the class teacher(s). We hope you find the report informative and that you take the opportunity for a phone call if you have any further questions or concerns.

Many will be done in a slightly different way to maintain all safety measures we have got in place.
