Our class novel this half term is *Poppy Field* by Michael Morpurgo. The children will be using this to help improve their descriptive writing. This beautiful book will also be the inspiration for our art work this half term. Our topic is textiles so we will be working with fabrics to create something really special.

In maths, we will be continuing to secure our knowledge and understanding of the 4 operations and we will be having a big focus on timestables and fluency with those key elements of maths.

This half term, we will be looking at *Electricity* in science which the children have launched with some excellent, creative homework!

Our RE work this half term asks the question *Why are festivals important to religious communities?* As we move into December our RE will be focussed on Christmas.

In computing we will be covering online safety whilst in French we will be revising some of the topics from last year including *Moi, Les Couleurs* and *La Jungle*.

In PSHE we will be thinking about decision making when it comes to money.

Our music this year will be a singing module focussed on Mamma Mia. Meanwhile, in PE we will be enjoying gymnastics and swimming sessions.

Our Forest Schools with Mr Haughton will be focussed on *Autumn Changes*.

Children should continue learning their timestables. We will be building up a bank of activities to support timestables on google classroom.

Spellings and timestables tests will take place on a *Friday*.
