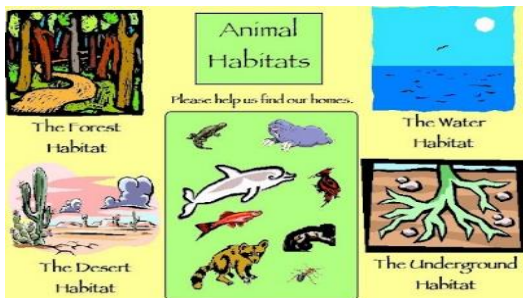

Welcome back everyone and I hope you've had a lovely half term break.

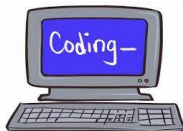
We have another very busy half term ahead in the run up to Christmas but lots of fun activities happening too!
