I hope you had a great Easter break- it is lovely to be back at school and we are looking forward to a productive summer term!

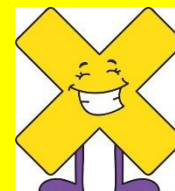
I wanted to say a big thankyou for your support with our class production. The children absolutely loved it. They did a great job and we were all very proud of them.

#### **Homework**

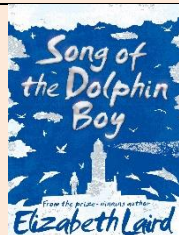
