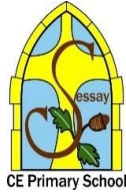
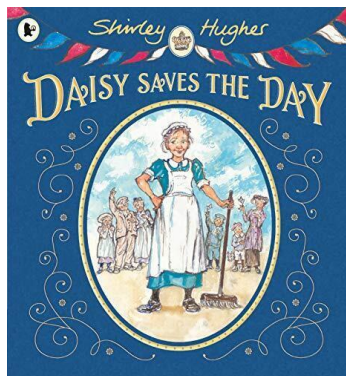


# Fountains Newsletter Summer 1 2023
