## Bolton Newsletter Autumn 1 2023






Welcome back and we hope everyone has enjoyed a lovely summer holiday spending time with family and friends.

'THE ROMANS' is our topic this term and our first class text is

We will learn how to retrieve information from a text and gather information about the main characters and move on to make inferences about things that happen in the story. We will also predict what may happen next using clues from the text.

Maths - Place Value, counting in different intervals, Roman numerals, rounding numbers, partitioning numbers, ordering and comparing numbers and the Year 4's will be introduced to negative numbers. We will also be working hard to learn all out times tables this year
